## POST-DOCTORAL T32 FELLOWSHIP IN CARDIOVASCULAR DISEASE EPIDEMIOLOGY

Sponsored by the National Heart, Lung and Blood Institute (NHLBI) of the National Institutes of Health (NIH), this program focuses on 1) Non-Invasive Subclinical Disease Measures, 2) Population-based CVD Outcomes Research and 3) High Risk and International Populations.

This fellowship includes didactic training in public health epidemiology as well as practical experience in epidemiologic and prevention-based studies.

The standard post-doctoral fellowship duration is 2 years – fellows receive a stipend commensurate with their level of training and other benefits. We are committed to increasing representation of underserved minorities in this fellowship program.

We have one open position at the post-doctoral level beginning as early as April, 2016. We are currently accepting applications for this position.
